Ironbark's true wood has the highest natural resistance to rot and fungus and is classified as naturally termite resistant. This gives Ironbark decking a life expectancy greater than 40 years, the highest rating available for natural timber.

Ironbark's longevity and strength are second to none, with examples of centuries old construction that can still be seen today in bridges, wharfs and decks in some of the harshest environments across the globe.

Hurford's Ironbark decking is PEFC certified, which meets some of the strictest environment criteria in the world and is only harvested from sustainable managed forests.
